a: Contribution field, b: Title (Topic of the thesis), c: Abstract (up to 300-words), d: Corresponding Author, e: Keywords, f: Name(s) of the author(s), affiliation, mailing address, zip code, telephone and fax number, and email address, g: Project number, if funded by The Ministry of Education or The Ministry of Science and Technology.
